New Business & Coach Update:

- **Booster President Updates:**
 - **Spring Uniforms** – 100 hats have been ordered (for upcoming Spring season and SY 2024-25 summer camp); uniform final decisions are TBD (Coach Chris said that team will likely use the maroon jerseys from the Fall; and the boosters can order the white jerseys, which will take 2-3 weeks to get delivered once ordered).  - **Cahuilla Park update** – work at the park has been completed and looks great.
 - **Senior Banners** – Geoff Bilau has agreed to get these banners completed. We have six seniors. Thank you!
- **Coach Updates:**
 - **TryOuts** – Try outs for Spring Season start tomorrow.
 - **Team Schedules** – First games/varsity tourney are this coming weekend; and Coach Reynoso is updating the school sports website with the schedule for the three teams. MaxPreps schedule does not include tournaments outside of League play; League play in the Spring will include games M-W-F each week for all three teams Each coach will determine their practice schedule. Varsity should expect 25-26 games total in Spring and Frosh/JV should expect 20-22.
 - **Coaching Updates** – Coach Nick has agreed to help out for JV until the new coach is cleared through the AD. The new coach for the Freshman team is Coach Kyle from PFA. He has been cleared.
