New Business & Coach Update:

- **Booster President Updates:**
 - **Spring Spirit Pack (\$250/player) - The jerseys and hats from the Spring spirit packs have been handed out, and the zip cage jackets and water bottles will be ready soon. Not all families have paid. Please pay as soon as possible. Only families that have paid will get the cage jackets and water bottles. Let the boosters know if the funds are an issue for you. Parents provided feedback that the font of the "C" on the hats isn't loved by the team.**
 - **CHS Open House (3/5) - The boosters have been offered a table at tomorrow's Open House. Lillian will be there selling shirts and sweatshirts and would welcome other parents and players to join her.**
 - **Upcoming Restaurant Fundraiser - Thank you to Daniel and Rose Rascon for helping coordinate Saturday's fundraiser dinner at Casa Maguey in the Claremont Village. It's a buffet offering for \$30/pp (the baseball program will make \$14 on each ticket sold). The final count is due on Friday. We only have sold 17 tickets so far.**
 - **Day of Service - The boosters have been offered an opportunity to do service with the LA Food Bank, prepping food boxes for area food pantries. Lillian asked for feedback, if families were interested. Reaction was mixed, but enough people said they could be interested, so she will work out a date after Spring Break.**
- **Senior Day Committee Report: Joelle Green reported that the committee would like to ask for \$250 to purchase balloons, flowers, ribbons and other items for senior day. Senior parents will prepare a table for pictures of each senior and Freshman, Sophomores and Juniors will be asked to bring something fun for goodie bags for each of the seniors.
